## Travel Directions:

### From the New York State Thruway:

At exit 32 (Westmoreland, Rome) leaving the collection both, turn right at the light, turn left at the next light (on to route 233), straight to 4 corners (Westmoreland), turn left at this light (on to Stone Rd.), straight thru to the 4 corners (Stop Sign, Walesville, approximately 2 miles), straight thru the intersection (you are now on Halsey Rd.), you will travel approximately 1 mile straight to Judd Rd, just before you get to the intersection, you will see a driveway and parking lot to your left, this is the 40&8 – Oneida County Voiture 92.

### From Rome, NY:

Follow signs to route 233, travel south on route 233 to Stanwick Heights, Sutcliff Rd. (route 840) turn-off is on the left (@ light), approximately 2 miles from route 365, turn left onto Sutcliff Rd. (route 840) and follow it straight thru to Airport Rd. approximately 3 miles (you will pass the Sheriff Department on your right) travel straight thru the intersection (traffic light) you are now on Judd Rd. (still route 840) follow Judd Rd. (route 840), (you will travel over the New York State Thruway), straight up the hill and past the Electric Yard to the to the intersection of Judd Rd. (route 840) and Halsey Rd., approximately 3 miles, at light, turn right on to Halsey Rd., you will see a driveway and parking lot on your right, this is the 40&8 – Oneida County Voiture 92.

### From Utica, NY:

Follow route 69 (Oriskany Blvd.) straight into Whitesboro, to the 4 corners of Clinton St. and the Blvd. (Rite Aide is on the corner), turn left at this light (onto Clinton St.), straight up the hill (you will pass the Harts Hill Inn on your left, and Clinton st. becomes Clark Mills Rd. at the intersection (traffic light) of Clinton Rd.) travel straight thru intersection (you will pass Harts Hill Elementary School on your right, approximately 2.5 miles from Oriskany Blvd.), Halsey Rd. is approximately 1 mile up on the right (bear to the right at the “Y”), straight thru to the intersection of Halsey Rd. and Judd Rd. (route 840) approximately 1 mile, straight thru this intersection (traffic light), you will see a driveway and parking lot on your right, this is the 40&8 – Oneida County Voiture 92.
